- I. TITLE: Administrative Orders, Consent Orders, and Sanction Letters issued by HEALTH REGULATION (HR).
- II. SUBJECT: Sanctions completed during the period August 1, 2013, through August 31, 2013.
- III. FACT: For the period August 1, 2013, through August 31, 2013, Health Regulation is reporting two (2) Emergency Suspension Orders.

IV. ANALYSIS: Brian Alan Dorsey, 139 Jay Circle, Moore, SC 29369. Under an Emergency Suspension Order executed August 1, 2013, Mr. Dorsey's EMT-Intermediate Certificate was immediately suspended on an emergency basis. The sanction was imposed resulting in the execution of the emergency suspension order as a result of Mr. Dorsey being arrested on July 16, 2013 by the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office and taken into custody at the Spartanburg County Detention Center for a violation of S.C. Code Ann. § 16-3-652, criminal sexual conduct in the first degree, and S.C. Code Ann. § 16-11-312, burglary in the second degree. On July 18, 2013, Mr. Dorsey was indicted for criminal sexual conduct in the first degree and burglary in the second degree. The Department determined that a clear and present danger would exist to the public health, safety or welfare if Mr. Dorsey's EMT certificate was not suspended, pending further investigation and monitoring of the outcome of Mr. Dorsey's arrest and indictment.

Previous Sanctions: None

Ryan Edward Bolick, 1018 Bridlewood Farms, Ridgeville, SC 29472.

Under an Emergency Suspension Order executed August 28, 2013, Mr. Bolick's EMT-Paramedic Certificate was immediately suspended on an emergency basis. The sanction was imposed resulting in the execution of the emergency suspension order as a result of Mr. Bolick being taken into custody on August 9, 2012 by the Charleston County Sheriff's Office. The Charleston County Sheriff's Office obtained three warrants for Mr. Bolick. One warrant was for a violation of S.C. Code Ann. § 16-15-140 (repealed by 2012 Act No. 255, § 14, eff June 18, 2012), committing or attempting a lewd act upon a child under sixteen; and two warrants were for charges of criminal sexual conduct with

a minor in the second degree in violation of S.C. Code Ann. § 16-3-655(B) (Supp. 2012). The Department determined that a clear and present danger would exist to the public health, safety or welfare if Mr. Bolick's EMT certificate was not suspended, pending further investigation and monitoring of the outcome of Mr. Bolick's arrest and indictment.

Mr. Bolick has since appeared in court and pled guilty to a lesser offense (contributing to the delinquency of a minor), a charge which is not a felony. As a result of the plea, the Solicitor has dismissed the three indictments on felony charges which were the basis for issuing the Department's emergency suspension order. Therefore the Department has lifted the emergency suspension order and re-issued Mr. Bolick's certification.
