The Bureau of Air Quality has received your request on August 24, 2012, regarding the plans to install a voluntary odor control device at the Associated Asphalt Columbia, LLC t/a Seaco Emulsions site. The proposal is to duct the vents from the existing asphalt emulsion tanks to a carbon canister. This configuration is strictly for odor control and will not alter the plant as currently permitted. This installation does not allow for an increase in emissions or an increase in production activity.

This project will not require a construction permit because the addition of the odor control system is voluntary and will not increase emissions (SC R. 61-62.1 Section II(A)(1)(b)). You may proceed with the installation upon receipt of this letter. The facility will operate under the terms and conditions of its current operating permit.
