General Information

- ArborNature, LLC
 - Transfer Station
 - Composting Facility
 - 26 Summit Drive on Hilton Head Island, SC
 - The site is approximately 4 acres
 - Proposed to Store 240 tons of Construction & Demolition (C&D) Debris
- Approved by Town of Hilton Head for zoning

Station

A place where solid waste is taken from collection vehicles and placed in other transportation units for movement to another solid waste management facility.


Some material may be recycled at the facility



Permits Required

- Solid Waste Transfer Station Permit
- Composting Permit
- Construction Stormwater Permit
- Coastal Zone Consistency Determination

*An air permit may be needed for the composting facility





Acceptable Wastes

Includes (but not limited to):

- Asphalt, concrete, bricks, C&D debris, and Land-clearing debris
- Box Springs and Mattresses
- Glass
- Shingles
- Asbestos
- Lead-Based Paint
- Dead Animals















Unacceptable Wastes

Includes (but not limited to):

- Items Containing PCBs
- Petroleum Contaminated Waste
- Sludges



Infectious Waste



Hazardous Waste



Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Household Trash



What Is Considered in DHEC's Permitting Decision?

Buffers

- Design Criteria
- Items Prescribed in the Regulation
 - Reg. 61-107.7 SWM: Transfer of Solid Waste



Buffer Requirements

The operating area is required to be:

- 100 feet from property line
- 200 feet from any surface water, excluding drainage ditches and sedimentation ponds
- 200 feet from residences, schools, hospitals or recreational park areas
- 100 feet from any drinking water well
- Shall not be located in wetlands
- Whenever possible, transfer stations shall not be constructed in a 100-yr flood plain





Design Criteria

- Proper on-site roads
- Access Control
- Signage
- Agreement with a fire department
- Low permeability pad



Design Criteria

Solid wastes identified as nonputrescible (material that does not decay) recyclables or oversized, bulky, or untreatable solid waste may be temporarily stored outside on the premises for a period not to exceed one (1) week. Therefore, the following design criteria may not be required:

- Water supply for cleaning the pad; and, equipped with drains or pumps
- Enclosed building
- Exhaust removal system



What Isn't Considered in DHEC's Permitting Process?

- Traffic on Roads
- General Opposition
- Property Values
- Zoning/Land Use
- Incompatible Use
- Alternative/Better Locations



Permitting Process

Technical application and review

March 4, 2020	Technical Application received
June 10, 2020	Notice of Draft Permit
August 18, 2020	Notice of Public Meeting and Public Hearing by publication in <i>The Island Packet</i>
September 10, 2020	Public Meeting
September 17, 2020	Public Hearing
September 25, 2020	DHEC public comment period closes



Next Steps

DHEC will review all comments received

- DHEC will make a final decision and provide a written response to all comments
- Final decision date begins 15-day appeal period
