



## **B2 Participation Activities**

**NOTE:** The first five activities are required.

Vehicle Counting Activity (Baseline & Final) for cars and buses. Required	
Install/Post Anti-Idling signs in the appropriate car rider/bus lanes (provided by DHEC/BAQ). Required	
Adopt an Anti-Idling Policy for all vehicles (including buses, parents, staff, and visitors). Required	
Educate the parents, bus drivers, faculty and staff about your B2 program and anti- idling policies. Required	
Post pictures of your B2 campaign on your school's website and/ or send pictures to the B2 coordinator. Required	
Participate in the Environmental Protection Agencies (EPA) Air Quality Flag Program. Your school will receive garden flags (pole not included) that correspond to the Air Quality Index (AQI).	
Survey the parents asking them if they would consider transportation options such as carpooling to school, walking to school, busing to school, etcThen plan/promote most popular answers.	
Promote your B2 Program through the school newsletter, web site, and other media sources.	
Create and have parents and bus drivers participate in a pledge signing to stop idling	
Display a "No Idling Zone" Banner in a prominent area (provided by DHEC/BAQ while supplies last)	
During morning announcements, announce the air quality index level and display the appropriate corresponding colored flag	
Incorporate Air Quality Lessons into the Curriculum. Go to Program Resources for lesson plans and ideas	
Teach a lesson from the "Take Action SC" lesson resources.	
Plan a Walk and Bike to School Event	
Install Air Quality Landscape Project-contact your local Urban	
Paint "No Idle Zone" on the school car rider and bus lanes	
Create and maintain an air quality bulletin board	
Establish and maintain an Environmental Club. The members can take part in helping with the vehicle count.	
Recruit new B2 schools, businesses, and other community partners
