A CED does not include a video display device that is part of a motor vehicle or that is contained within a household appliance or commercial, industrial, or medical equipment (e.g., video display device that is contained within a MRI machine, control panel, cash register, clothes washer, clothes dryer, refrigerator, refrigerator and freezer, microwave oven, conventional oven or range, dishwasher, room air-conditioner, dehumidifier, air purifier, etc.).</p>
MN	Monitors, Televisions	<p>As of July 2016, program goals are based on sales of TVs and monitors of any screen size, but the program allows households to recycle a larger group of products, including desktop/laptop computers, tablets keyboards, printers, fax machines, DVD players, and video cassette recorders.</p>

NY	CRT Monitor, Desktops, E-device power cords and chargers, E-readers, External Hard Drive, Flat Panel/LCD Monitors, Game Consoles, Keyboards, Mice, Monitors, Portable DVD, Portable Music/Media Player, Printers, Scanners, Servers, Tablets	<p>Complete list of products covered: CRT's, all-in-one computers, desktops, e-readers, interactive flat panel displays, laptops, mini computers, tablets, thin clients, workstations, printers, 3D printers, label printers, scanners, keyboards, mice or similar pointing devices, fax machines, monitors, cable or satellite receivers, digital converter boxes, DVD players, DVR's, electronic or video game consoles, portable digital music players w/ memory capability, projectors w/ DVD player capability, VCR's, small scale servers, and televisions</p> <p>Cell phone takeback = separate law.</p>

MI	Desktops, Laptops, Monitors, Printers, Tablets, Televisions	iPads and Kindle fires are computers and would be covered. Kindle readers are not computers, and are not covered devices.
TX	Desktops, Keyboards, Laptops, Monitors, Tablets, Televisions	Keyboard and mouse must accompany computer equipment being recycled
VA	Desktops, Keyboards, Laptops, Monitors	Manufacturers do NOT have to register for peripherals, but they are considered 'covered' under the collection program
VT	Desktops, Laptops, Monitors, Printers, Tablets, Televisions	Manufacturers do NOT have to register for peripherals, but they are considered 'covered' under the collection program

SC	Desktops, Laptops, Monitors, Printers, Televisions	Manufacturers of covered devices must register and offer a recovery program, but only television/computer monitor manufacturers have a recycling obligation of 80% of their prior year's market sales by weight.
PA	Desktops, E-readers, Keyboards, Laptops, Monitors, Printers, Tablets, Televisions	Manufacturers of only printers or other peripherals do not have to register their devices-for other manufacturers they are considered covered devices.
IL	Computers, Desktops, Digital Converter Boxes, DVD, E-readers, Fax, Game Consoles, Keyboards, Laptops, Mice, Monitors, Portable DVD, Portable Music/Media Player, Printers, Scanners, Servers, Tablets, Televisions, VCRs	PDA, Zip drive. E-readers must be multi-function to be accepted.
DC	Desktops, DVD, E-readers, Game Consoles, Keyboards, Laptops, Monitors, Portable Music/Media Player, Printers, Scanners, Servers, Tablets, Televisions	Printers/Scanners must weigh less than 100 pounds.
IN	E-readers, Laptops, Monitors, Tablets, Televisions	Program goals are based on sales of video display devices, but the program allows consumers, public schools and small businesses to recycle a larger group of products, including computers, keyboards, printers, fax machines, DVD players, and video cassette recorders. E-readers must be multi-function to be accepted.
WI	Desktops, E-readers, Laptops, Monitors, Servers, Tablets, Televisions	Program goals are based on sales of video display devices, computers and printers, but the program allows consumers and K-12 schools to recycle a larger group of products, including keyboards, mice, fax machines, DVD players, and video cassette recorders. Free recycling is not guaranteed.

RI	Desktops, Laptops, Monitors, Tablets, Televisions	The law doesnotcover printers and other computer peripherals (e.g. cables, mouse or keyboards) and numerous exemptions are included in the law (e.g. for computers/TVs/video display devices in cars and incorporated into large pieces of equipment, including home appliances).
