The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) has reviewed the investigation report. The following comments were generated during this review:

1. The Department is requesting future reports include historical groundwater levels and field sampling notes.
2. The Department concurs with Marsh Lumber that the pentachlorophenol (PCP) concentrations are on a declining trend.
3. Since the bio-sparging remediation is ongoing and PCP concentrations are declining, the Department is requesting a meeting following the next three groundwater sampling events to determine the path forward for the Feasibility Study.
4. The Department is requesting additional surface water sampling locations along the former storm drain line. Please submit a sampling work plan in thirty (30) days to my attention.
