SC DHEC vs. Atlantic Steel Ind. Inc., et al; US District Court #6:04-23349-13 & Consolidated Cases

Notice of Intent to Settle and Opportunity for Public Comment

The SC Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) has reached a settlement agreement (Agreement) related to the former Stoller Chemical Site (Site) located at 7747 Highway 17 South, Jericho, SC. The Agreement relates to the recovery of a portion of DHEC's costs of response for the release and threatened release of hazardous substances, pollutants, or contaminants at the Site. The Agreement provides for the release of SJWG from further liability to DHEC and contribution claims.

The Agreement between the parties was reached pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), 42 U.S.C. §§ 9613 and 9622 and the SC Hazardous Waste Management Act (HWMA), S.C. Code Ann. § 44-56-200, et seq. (as amended).
