Influenza Indicators


South Carolina reported **widespread activity** this week.

This week **1,750** lab-confirmed tests were reported. In the current flu season, there have been **45,458** lab-confirmed tests reported.



Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance

The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was **6.7%**, which is **above** South Carolina's baseline (**3.2%**). The ILI activity level overall was **high**.



Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations

This week **145** influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported by **49** hospitals. The cumulative hospitalization rate is **76.9 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **3906** influenza-associated hospitalizations.

Influenza-Associated Deaths

This week, **9** influenza-associated deaths were reported; however, **5** deaths occurred during previous weeks. The cumulative mortality rate is **1.9 per 100,000**. In the current flu season, there have been **98** influenza-associated deaths.





Laboratory-Confirmed Influenza Cases, 2021-22 Season to Present





Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) Surveillance


This week, the ILI activity level was **high** and **6.7%** of patient visits to SC ILINet providers were attributed to an influenza-like illness. This is **above** the state baseline of **3.2%**.

Reports were received from providers in **20** counties, representing all DHEC Public Health regions.


ILI percentage is dependent upon the number of reporting providers and/or can vary by disease activity or the number of providers submitting reports.

State ILI Activity Level by MMWR Week, 2017-18 Influenza Season to Present



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
