Tonnage Determination

On March 3, 2020, staff initiated a review to determine if the above referenced landfill is eligible to receive an increase to the permitted maximum yearly disposal rate. The site currently has a permitted tonnage of 438,000 tons per year. According to the published FY2018 annual report, the Anderson Regional Class 3 Landfill disposed of 426,631 tons. This satisfies the requirement that the facility must be operating within 20% of the permitted yearly disposal rate. Also, the permitted rate of 438,000 is less than 30% of the total Class 3 waste generated in the State.

The current tonnage limit was established in September 1, 1999. Therefore, the FY2018 DON Data was evaluated against the FY2000 DON Data to determine the difference in Class 3 waste generated since the last tonnage increase. The total waste generated in FY2000 was 3,948,549 tons. This figure was compared to the waste generated in FY2018, which was 4,962,620 tons. Therefore, the waste being generated within the State has increased by 1,014,071 tons since the fiscal year of the previous tonnage increase.

In conclusion, the Anderson Regional Class 3 Landfill meets the requirements of Regulation 61-107.17, Section D.3.c.2 and is eligible to receive an increase of 150,000 tons per year. Therefore, the new maximum yearly disposal rate will now be established at 588,000 tons per year.
